



PK-K Mardi Gras Shoebox Parade Tuesday, February 28, 2017

The Mardi Gras Shoebox Parade is a celebration to help students understand the season of Lent. Teachers will discuss with the students the importance of goals during Lent season.

Each student will place their goal in their shoebox before they seal and decorate it.

Students will take the box home on Wednesday, March 1st. to give them a visual reminder of their goals throughout Lent.

Students will prepare their Mardi Gras Shoebox Float at home with their parents: (Instructions)

- 1 - Place your child's and/or your family's goal in the shoebox before decorating. This is an excellent opportunity to form a family Lenten goal.
- 2 - Seal the box and decorate using Mardi Gras colors. Purple represents Justice, Gold represents Power, and Green represents Faith.
- 3 - Attach a ribbon, thin rope, cord, etc. to pull the box. Regular shoeboxes are the easiest for the students to pull. (Large unstable floats tend to fall over).

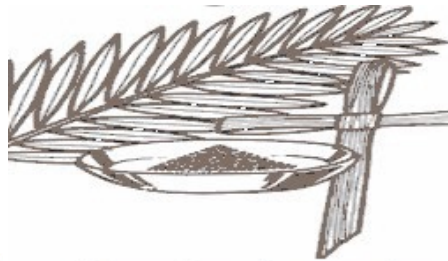


Mission

2 - Decore la caja usando los colores de “Mardi Gras”. El morado representa justicia, el dorado representa poder y el verde representa la fé.

3 - Sujete un listón o cordón a la caja para que el niño-a pueda estirarla. (Las cajas de zapatos son las mas prácticas para que los niños puedan estirarlas, cajas grandes tienden a caerse).
